

Home/School Partnership Agreement

- We will communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, text, email and the school website
- We will respond to communications from parents in a timely manner, following school policies

We – the students – also agree to do these things:

- We will show respect and kindness to all members of the Imberhorne community
- We will wear the correct school uniform
- We will take responsibility for what we say and do
- We will work proactively to make amends if things go wrong.
- We will attend school every day
- We will bring to school all the equipment we need every day
- We will understand and follow the school rules
- · We will behave well and follow the school behaviour policy
- We will all join in fully in student activities
- We will care for others and encourage their development
- We will work to make the school a place where everyone can learn
- We will aim to attend one extracurricular activity a term
